


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




Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to solder point as a function of pulse duration.

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



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

Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values.






Fig 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values.



 $a = \frac{R_{DSon}}{R_{DSon(25^{\circ}C)}}$


Fig 8. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature.

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


Fig 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage.



 $V_{GS} = 0 V$; f = 1 MHz


Fig 11. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values.

 $I_D = 1 A; V_{DD} = 30 V$


Fig 13. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values.


