



**Fig 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of solder point temperature**




T<sub>sp</sub> = 25°C; I<sub>DM</sub> is single pulse




Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values






Fig 6. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values





Fig 7. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage





Fig 8. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature





**Fig 9. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values**





**Fig 10. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature**





**Fig 11. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values**



**Fig 13. Source current as a function of source-drain voltage; typical values**




**Fig 14. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values**
