

Ruland USKC24-12-12-F, 3/4" x 3/4" Single Universal Joint, Needle Bearing, Steel, Set Screw With Keyway, 1.495" OD, 4.250" Length





Description

Ruland USKC24-12-12-F is a single cardan needle bearing universal joint with 0.7500" x 0.7500" bores, 3/16" x 3/16" keyways, 1.495" OD, 4.250" length, and 5/16-18 set screws. It is ideal for applications where higher accuracy, service life, and speed are required. This needle bearing universal joint is comprised of needle roller bearings, precision machined trunnions with hardened and ground journals, and two yokes for reduced friction and increased performance in high performance applications. USKC24-12-12-F is designed for use in high RPM applications up to 6000 RPM and has extended service life due to pre-lubricated maintenance free bearings. It is made from high grade alloy steel for durability and high strength. When combined with bootUBOOT24/38-NI-KIT the joint is protected from unwanted contaminants such as dust or water and self lubricates reducing maintenance time. This single cardan universal joint is manufactured in the USA by Belden Universal for strict control of processes.
