




Transfer Characteristics




On-Resistance vs. Drain Current










Gate Charge




Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage






On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage





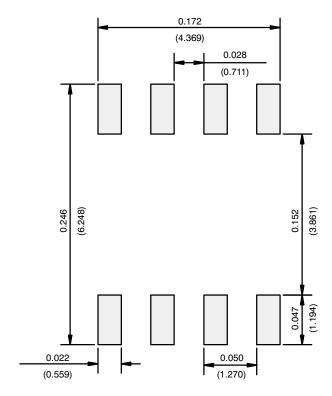
