## 1. Product profile

### 1.1 General description

Standard level N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to the appropriate AEC standard for use in automotive critical applications.





**Fig 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature**








**Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration**






**Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**


**Fig 6. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage**

**Fig 7. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values**



**Fig 8. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**





**Fig 9.** Gate-source voltage as a function of turn-on gate charge; typical values





**Fig 10.** Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature





**Fig 11.** Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values



**Fig 13.** Input, output and reverse capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values


