





Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage






Single Pulse Power








Current Derating*







Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient

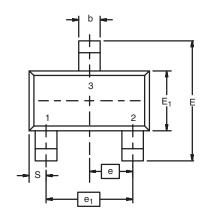


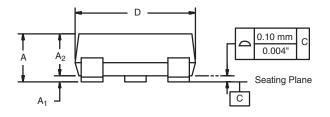
Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Foot

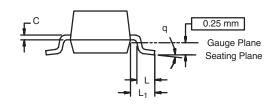

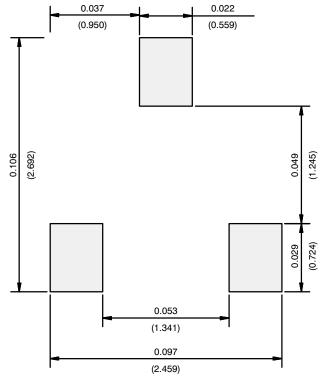
