


**Output Characteristics**




**Transfer Characteristics**




**On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage**



**Capacitance**




**Gate Charge**




**On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature**




**Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage**




**On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage**



**Reverse Current (Schottky)**




**Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient**




**Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient**





**Power, Junction-to-Case**

\* The power dissipation  $P_D$  is based on  $T_{J(max)} = 150$  °C, using junction-to-case thermal resistance, and is more useful in settling the upper dissipation limit for cases where additional heatsinking is used. It is used to determine the current rating, when this rating falls below the package limit.
